Tsukishima Kikai Co., Ltd. Formally Signs Mixer Products License Agreement with Zeppelin Systems GmbH

Tsukishima Kikai Co., Ltd. ("TSK"; Headquarters: Chuo-ku, Tokyo, Japan; President and Representative Director: Yoshiyuki Fukuzawa) is pleased to announce that it has executed a license agreement with Zeppelin Systems GmbH ("Zeppelin Systems"), a German plant engineering company with 1,700 employees worldwide, concerning its mixer products.

Since the 1980s, TSK has developed its mixer business by customizing the technology of German-based mixer manufacturer MTI Mischtechnik International GmbH for the Japanese market under a licensing agreement. Meanwhile, the Japanese mixer market has evolved through technology licenses from both HENSCHTEL and MTI since the mid-20th century. In the 2000s, both companies became part of Zeppelin Systems, enabling the integration of their technologies, expertise, and know-how.

While TSK announced a strategic partnership with Zeppelin Systems in September 2025, the execution of this manufacturing and sales license agreement represents a concrete milestone in advancing that partnership.

Through this agreement, TSK will be able to manufacture HENSCHTEL-Mixers® utilizing the latest technologies of the brand, in addition to its existing MTI-Mixers™ lineup. This will enable TSK to provide the following solutions:

- Supply HENSCHTEL-Mixers® as well as MTI-Mixers™ manufactured by TSK to customers in Japan as well as Japanese companies operating globally.
- Promote sales of both HENSCHTEL-Mixers® and MTI-Mixers™ and provide technical support services for installed mixers throughout Japan.
- Deliver comprehensive customer support covering everything from equipment selection to maintenance, ensuring optimal performance and customer satisfaction.
- Accelerate the introduction of next-generation mixers, combining the strengths of both the HENSCHTEL-Mixers® and MTI-Mixers™, particularly for the battery industry, and provide these advanced solutions promptly to Japanese customers.

Building on this license agreement, TSK and Zeppelin Systems will maximize the value of their technologies and innovations in industrial mixer markets where Japanese manufacturers have strong global competitiveness, including battery materials, food, pharmaceuticals, and chemicals. Together, the two companies will deliver world-class mixing solutions that meet the increasingly sophisticated and evolving needs of customers.
